7:05 Commence

- Fran Burnszynski from Baltimore City Parking Authority discussed EV charging stations.
 - Linwood Ave chargers are level 2.
 - Fast chargers are prioritized near interstates.
 - Ability to restrict parking isn't legislated, curtailing enforcement options.
 - BGE charging program has distributed all of the equipment. More installations are unlikely.
 - EV installations require 6 parking spaces.
 - The selection process for new site locations is: Identify where power facilities exist; Solicit consent from land owner (typically Baltimore Recs and Parks); Engage with the city councilperson who decides whose permission is required.
- FPCA has a board vacancy for VP. Also seeking committee volunteers.
- Safety: Commander's Meeting: Opportunistic crimes up, major crimes down, trending with cold weather.
 - Butts and Bettys arrest after couple get in fights with other patrons, caused vandalism and later returned to the bar.
 - Amazon truck vs. pedestrian driver not charged with felony.
 - There will be a safety walk in scheduled for mid-April. Suggestions for areas to focus on are requested.
- Beautification: Dumpster and clean-up event on April 5th. Dumpster will be at intersection of Gough and Chester from 8-11am. More details to come about the cleanup event.
